WE'RE FLANKED—Fishers Hill, Va., September 22, 1864

A limited edition print (37x 25.5 inches) by nationally acclaimed artist Gary Casteel

The scene depicted is the western end of Jubal Early's Confederate infantry line at Fishers Hill immediately before Union General George Crook's famous flanking maneuver burst upon their positions. This led to the collapse of the Confederate line.
